#### Relocation:

In case of an emergency that would require relocation for MSCC children and staff we will transport children to the following location:

If the need for transportation arises MSCC Center Director will contact Georgetown ISD bus barn at **512 943-5126** and arrange for a bus to be sent to the Children's Center. In the event no buses are available we will transport children by Main Street Church bus and the personal vehicles of our staff.

Our safe zone inside the building is: The basement area of the church

Our outside safe zone that **does not** require transportation is the tree outside the playground on the south side of the building.

MSCC is on an automatic monitoring system when alarm is activated emergency services are notified through alarm company.

If needed the Director or manager in charge will notify necessary authorities.

Parents will be notified via phone by Center staff in case of emergency or relocation.

Licensing will be notified within 24 hrs of any emergency.
